



AIR DIVING

Working Depth:
Surface down to 50 meters

Maximum Duration:
3 hours/diver/day, decompression included

Breathing Gas:
Compressed air or oxygen mix

Decompression:
In water

Equipments:
Surface supplied equipment, LARS and decompression chamber

WET BELL DIVING

Working Depth:
Surface down to 75 meters

Maximum Duration:
3 hours/diver/day, decompression included

Breathing Gas:
Compressed air, heliox

Decompression:
Inside a wet bell

Equipments:
Wet bell and decompression chamber

BOUNCE/TUP DIVING

Working Depth:
20 to 80 meters

Maximum Duration:
1 to 3 hours/diver/day, decompression not included

Breathing Gas:
Heliox

Decompression:
Inside a surface decompression chamber

Equipments:
TUP-System

SATURATION DIVING

Working Depth:
50 to 200 meters

Maximum Duration:
6 to 24 hours/diver/day over a period of 21 days

Breathing Gas:
Heliox

Decompression:
At the end of the work

Equipments:
SAT-System, life chamber, gas regeneration units
